**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- ✓ Participants must be 18 or older, ready to work full time after completing program, have 4 months clean from substances, be able to participate in all parts of a 35 hour/week program (9 AM to 5 PM). GROCERYworks applicants (not HOPEworks) must be able to work flexible hours (including nights and weekends) and be available to work part-time hours to start.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:**

ID that shows you can work in the US (eg., NY State issued identification and a social security card).

**WHEN YOU CAN GO:**

To get started, attend an information session any Tuesday or Thursday at 8:45 AM. Info sessions include a tour of HOPE, meeting staff and other prospective students, learning about the program, and completing an application. No appointment is necessary, but you must arrive on time. Plan to spend 4-5 hours at HOPE.
