

QUEENSBRIDGE SCHOLARSHIP FUND GENERAL INFORMATION

Awards

Four (4) awards in the amount of five hundred dollars (**\$500.00**) each will be awarded to resident winners from Queensbridge and/or Ravenswood.

Eligibility

All of the following rules are applicable:

1. Applicants must be in the second, third or final year of obtaining their undergraduate college degree (freshman are excluded) or pursuing a graduate degree.
2. Applicants must be residents of Queensbridge or Ravenswood houses.
3. Applicants must be enrolled in the upcoming school semester with a minimum of twelve (12) college credits. Exceptions will be made for applicants that need less than twelve (12) credits to complete their degree and for graduate students.
4. Applicants must complete the application in its entirety and are **required to answer the essay question**.

4. All applications must be submitted via first class mail only. Certified and registered mail will **NOT** be accepted.
5. A contact telephone number is mandatory for all applicants.
6. All applications must be postmarked by the **last Friday in July**.
7. Winners will be notified by the **second Friday in August**.
8. The Queensbridge Scholarship committee will not be responsible for late, ineligible or damaged applications that cannot be processed.
9. Any applicant that submits fraudulent information will automatically be disqualified. Award disbursements can be rescinded at any time prior to payment if the committee determines that fraudulent information was submitted. **All information will be verified!**

Selection Process

1. Winners will be selected by the scholarship committee.
2. The selection criteria will be conducted using a point system based on applicant essays, GPA, employment history, volunteer history, honors, awards, special recognition and extracurricular activities. All undergraduate students will receive 2-points added to their final score.
3. Awards not validated by winners within 10-days of the initial notification shall be forfeited.
4. All scholarship winners will be required to present proof of eligibility within 10-business days of being notified of their winning status.
5. Every attempt will be made to select substitute recipients from the original pool of applicants for any forfeited awards.

Award Disbursement

Award disbursements are made payable to and released directly to the winners.
